Fine 18th-century country residence with 360° panoramic views and over 7 hectares (17 acres) of land

Significant attention to detail is evident in the house's restoration: stone and old wood flooring, monumental fireplace, cooking range, kitchen units and sink carved in local stone and the use of noble materials throughout. Generous volumes and convivial spaces provide a sense of exceptional comfort and elegance.

The central feature of the house: a stunning, large drawing room of 58 m² with a 7-metre high ceiling, double exposure, abundant natural light and door onto a large terrace.

The layout of the interior includes:

- •An entrance hall-cum-study of 25m² with built-in bookcase and guest WC;
- •A magnificent 33m² kitchen with cooking range, opening into a covered terrace with stone tables in a former shelter for horse-drawn carriages a delightful outdoor living space;
- •A 16.5m² dining room adjacent to the kitchen.

On the first floor, two separate sleeping areas are accessed by old wood staircases:

- •Dne leading to the 34m² master suite with double exposure, 11m² dressing room, bathroom and toilet;
- •The other includes two adjoining bedrooms, with bathroom and toilet.

A pantry, laundry, boiler room and cellar complete the inside of the house.

A country refuge with spectacular 360° views and outbuildings

Set in over 7 hectares (17 acres), including 1.5 hectares of natural park, the property is approached via a drive of old plane trees, leading to a beautifully positioned house offering uninterrupted 360° views over the countryside, the Montagne Noire, and the Pyrenees on a clear day – all with complete privacy.

Outbuildings include:

- Two highly secured garages (67m² and 20m²), perfect for classic car storage or a hobby workshop;
- •A storage shed.

In addition:

•A building permit for a 50m² extension directly attached to the house has been acquired.
